This feature allows you to block your number from displaying on someone else's caller ID when dialing out, block incoming calls from specific numbers or block calls from others who hide their numbers from your caller ID. Press *67 on your phone and listen for a dial tone. Dial the number you are calling. Repeat this process for each call that you make, as this method will block your number for one call only. Press *60 on your phone and listen carefully to the announcement. It will tell you whether your service is on or off. Press 3 to turn this service on (or off), then press 1 to hear the numbers that are on your blocked list, if any. Press #01# to add the last number that called you to the list. Press # to add a new number to your list. The voice instructions will tell you to enter the area code and number, and then press # again. Press * to remove a number from your list. Voice instructions will then tell you to enter the area code and number, and then press #. Press 0 to hear all of the voice instructions again. Deactivate selective number rejection by following Steps 1 and 2. Press *77 on your phone and listen for a dial tone. Once you hear the second dial tone, you have activated call blocking of restricted numbers. Dial 1177 if you have a rotary phone to block callers with caller ID-blocked numbers. Deactivate this feature by dialing *87 or 1187. Navigate to Phone > Number to block > Information > Block on some devices it might be hold down on the number from the Phone app and select Block/report spam > Block.Ban numbers through your mobile carrier Account Settings.Use a mobile app like Calls Blacklist - Call Blocker. This article will explain how to block and stop spam calls (or robocalls) from bothering you. Unfortunately, permanently stopping spam calls is not possible. New numbers may always be able to get through, or in some cases, the call blocking only works for a certain amount of time. The best way to mitigate your exposure to telemarketers and spam callers is to limit how often you give out your number to third parties. However, there are a few different ways to stop or block spam calls on Android devices for an extended time. Some of those methods include: Your device's blocking feature.Installing a blocking app.Blocking calls through your carrier (mobile provider).Registering with the national DoNotCall service. The easiest way to block and prevent spam calls is to use your Android device settings via the built-in dialer app. It works best when the calls come from the same number. Here's how to block a number with the dialer: The calls will still show up for billing purposes, and may appear briefly on your phone, but they will not come through. Open your Phone app. In the call log, tap on the number you wish to block and then tap the information button. Tap Block in the bottom right or at the bottom of the screen. You can also long-press on the number you want to block and then select the Block option in the sub-menu that appears on some devices. And on some devices the process might be: Phone app > Recents > tap and hold the number you want to block > Block/report spam > Block. The exact process is going to differ based on what carrier you are subscribed to, for example Verizon versus AT&T. But, here's how to block calls through your mobile carrier: Not all mobile carriers will offer this feature. Visit your mobile carrier's account portal and login. Look for Account Settings. Find Call Block or Number Blocking options. Enter the number or information and click Save. Some providers, like Verizon, will only block calls for up to 90 days. After the period is up, you'll have to reenter any numbers you want to keep blocked. You may also encounter a cap on the number of numbers that you can block at any given time, as well. The FTC or Federal Trade Commission manages a national registry called the Do Not Call Registry. By adding your name, and number to the registry, companies should respect the list and avoid calling your number. If they call anyway, they face legal action. Registration is pretty straightforward. Just click the appropriate link page on the FCC's Do Not Call Registry page, enter the required information, and that's it. Your number is now listed as a "do not call" contact. The National Do Not Call Registry only applies to telemarketing calls. Scammers and shady spam callers do not pay it much attention. One popular app, Calls Blacklist - Call Blocker, is free and effective. One of its best features is you can create a safelist, using your contacts, and allow only the people you know to call you, blocking out all others. Of course, you can block individual numbers, as well. FAQ How do I unblock a number on Android 12? To unblock a number on Android, open the Phone app and tap More > Settings > Blocked Numbers. Tap the X next to the contact you want to unblock. For more options, Google Play has several call blocking apps. How do I block text messages on Android 12? It's an extension of caller ID, which displays the calling party's telephone number directly on your phone or on a device attached to your phone. You can read more about caller recognition in How does Caller ID work? Just as your fingerprint acts as a unique identifier, so does your phone number. Every time you place a phone call, the number you are calling from is transmitted along the phone line as a series of beeps at different frequencies. Even when your caller ID box reads "blocked," the number was still transmitted but was hidden from your view by the phone company at the caller's request. Many people subscribe to a service that prevents their number from displaying; you can also dial *67 to block your number from showing on certain calls. How Telephones Work will tell you all you want to know about sending information over phone lines. Without getting into all the technical details that it does, a phone call blocker works by recognizing those numbers that you've designated as prohibited, and instead of ringing your phone, it plays a message telling the person they've been blocked. Some phone call blockers can be programmed to reject calls from the last person who called. This way, even if you don't know the person's phone number you can still block unknown phone calls. With other screening devices, people with blocked numbers may be required to identify themselves if they want to reach you. Unfortunately, phone call blockers aren't foolproof. Persistent callers can often outwit these technologies. For example, phone spoofing, as it is sometimes called, alters the number that is transmitted as the call's origin so the caller won't be blocked. Placing a call with a calling card, using a pay phone or using VoIP can also evade blockers. If you receive threatening phone calls, you should contact the police. If you think about it, the prevalence of call screening devices is somewhat ironic. Telephones were invented to improve communication channels and enable people to connect to one another over long distances. Now there's a growing market for ways to shut down that channel and prevent people from connecting. What would Alexander Graham Bell think? How to tell you've been blocked on WhatsAppThere's no way to be 100% sure, as WhatsApp doesn't officially notify users when they're blocked, but there are a few things that could indicate that a contact has blocked you on WhatsApp, and putting all the clues together can give you a safe assumption after a while:You can't see when that person was last seen (i.e., when the person has last used WhatsApp) or online (i.e., when they last had WhatsApp open and connected to the internet). You can't see profile photos or photo updates. Messages show one check mark (sent) but not two (delivered). Calls to the contact fail. Of course, WhatsApp says that this isn't a hard-and-fast rule—these indicators don't guarantee that you've been blocked. If someone is offline, for example, you may only see one checkmark next to messages for a period of time, and calls won't go through. And certain privacy settings can limit who sees your "last seen" status.How to block a contact on WhatsAppThe ambiguity can be handy if you want to block someone you've been chatting with on WhatsApp without them knowing. They certainly won't get a notification or any clear signal that they've been blocked.G/O Media may get a commissionThere are a few ways to block a contact on WhatsApp. On both iOS and Android, you can go to Settings > Account > Privacy > Blocked (contacts) to add contacts to your blocked list. Alternatively, you can block individuals from their profile page. On iOS, open the chat and tap the contact's name and picture at the top of the window. If they're part of a group you're in, tap the group name, select the contact and tap Info to open their profile. At the bottom, tap Block Contact. On Android, tap More options (three vertical dots) > More > Block > Block. You can also block an unknown number directly from within your chat history.
